

What We Teach

The school day begins with pledges to the American flag, Christian flag, and Bible as the students learn to honor God and their country. Utilizing the A Beka curriculum, we strive for academic excellence in all of our classes, from MDO through Elementary.

MDO

Students are given opportunities to explore their world with creative play, while developing the vital learning skills and academic concepts they need.

2K

We provide an academic environment that is fun and stimulating. Students learn colors, shapes, numbers 1-10, how to count from 1 to 20, sharing with others and we work on potty training.

3K

Students learn basic academics including the alphabet, colors, shapes, numbers, and Bible stories. This class builds a solid academic foundation for the transition to the more academically advanced four year old class.

4K

In our 4K program, we provide a strong foundation for reading, writing, math, and language development. Students learn Bible lessons and memorize verses. Students completing the 4K class should be able to read simple sentences and will be on track to transition into Kindergarten.

Elementary Grades

A Beka curriculum is used to teach students Math, Language Arts, Reading/Phonics/Spelling, Social Studies, Science, and Bible. Additionally, students have Computer, Spanish, Music and Library classes.

Elementary Grades
